GENERAL INFORMATION

The purpose of the Bathurst Historic Car Club (BHCC) is to promote the use of Historic Motor Vehicles, in a family friendly environment.

The BHCC Code of Conduct is a guide as to the way BHCC Members should act, as agreed when applying for membership to the Club.

Code of Conduct - Members

Members **MUST**:

1. Abide by and be familiar with the Club Code of Conduct.
2. Abide by and be familiar with the Club Constitution.
3. Treat other people with welcoming respect and consideration.
4. Obey the Road Rules as prescribed, particularly those relating to Registration, Drugs and alcohol.
5. Take responsibility for their own actions. The Club will not accept responsibility for the negligence or actions of any person or persons whatsoever.
6. Make complaints regarding breaches of the Code of Conduct in writing to the President or Vice-President, to be addressed at a Committee Meeting.
7. Advise the Registrar of any changes to contact details.
8. Accept the decision of judges at events as being valid.
9. Comply with all aspects of HVS and CVS Registration.

Members must **NOT**:

1. Wilfully act in a manner prejudicial to the interests of harmony within the BHCC.
2. Act in a disrespectful, anti-social, abusive or undesirable manner towards another person or persons.
3. Do anything that may harm the reputation of the Club or any of its members.

Code of Conduct – Committee Members

1. Maintain confidentiality and comply with all requirements of Privacy legislation, particularly in respect to members' private information.
